All students registering for career camp 760, Healthcare Explorers Career Day Camp, will be required to complete a behavior contract, along with his/her guardian's signature, and **returned prior to admission**. Dear Parent and Healthcare Explorers Career Camp Student,

Thank you for registering your child for Bright Lights Healthcare Explorers Career Day Camp. We are delighted with your interest and wish to make the best placement for your child. Participation by students in our all-day Healthcare Explorers Career Camp can present some concerns based on student maturity in combination with higher-level course content and community site participation. The content of this day camp may be a leap above the K-5th grade classes offered at the main program site, Randolph Elementary School.

Good behaviors/attitudes are required. Mature/respectful behavior is necessary since students will be interacting with citizens and professionals at locations within the community. If behavior deteriorates, there is no "time out" with program administrators available to camp directors since classes are at community sites. Healthcare Explorers Career Day Camp demands the best behavior from students. Since the program is held in medical facilities where many don't feel well, medical protocol requires respectful, sensitive behavior from Bright Lights students.

Here are some of the exciting goals for career day-campers:

- Camp directors strive to have students meet professionals in the field and see their work. This exposure helps students begin to develop ideas about possible future careers.
- While efforts are made to make the camps hands-on/minds-on, presentations vary from year-to-year. Some may be lecture style, so concentration skills and politeness are necessary.
- Some projects are done in small groups to foster participation and peer cooperation.

One comment from a prior camper was, "This was my favorite class to ever take in Bright Lights because this is so interesting to me..."

To receive the greatest benefit from a Bright Lights career day camp experience, responses by students and parents/guardians on the questions below should generally be positive:

- I (s/he) have an interest in math and science.
- I (s/he) try to learn things that may be challenging.
- I (s/he) complete my work.
- I (s/he) am willing to work with others in a group to accomplish a project.
- I (s/he) enjoy learning and look for new places to learn.
- I (s/he) try to stay on task in the classroom.
- I (s/he) am a self starter.
