Behavioral Expectations for those who ride the Bright Lights buses.

1. Follow safety rules at all times, including:
 - a) Make sure the bus is stopped before leaving your seat to get off the bus.
 - b) Never put any part of your body outside the bus windows.
 - c) Don't talk to the driver while the bus is moving.
 - d) Don't put books, lunches or anything else in the bus aisles.
 - e) Report any damage to the bus to the driver.
 - f) Don't eat, drink or smoke on the bus.
 - g) Don't push or run when getting on or off the bus.
 - h) When crossing in front of the bus, watch for the driver's "all clear" signal before crossing.
 - i) Students must get on and off the bus only at the school stop(s) listed above.
 - j) Cross the road or street in front of the bus before it pulls away from the stop. This gives you the protection of the bus signal.
 - k) Nuisance items are not allowed on or around the bus. Examples of nuisance items include animals, water guns, rubber bands, balloons, etc.
2. Behave in a manner that is polite and not offensive to others on or around the bus. Inappropriate behaviors, including but not limited to bullying, intimidation, and harassment must be avoided.
3. Follow the directions of the bus driver.
4. Abide by the rules described in Lincoln Public Schools' **Rights and Responsibilities of Students and The Ride Guide**.
5. **The Bright Lights discipline policy – "two strikes and you are off the bus":**



1st offense – Driver will talk to the student about his/her behavior in an effort to correct it. Driver will give a written report to the Bright Lights staff about the offense. Bright Lights staff will counsel with the student, and a parent will be contacted.

2nd offense – Driver will give a written report to the Bright Lights staff, the parent will be contacted, and the student will lose the privilege of riding the bus.
