GENERAL INFORMATION

2. Each student is eligible for **one** partial scholarship for either a class or a day camp. Scholarship awards cover partial tuition and all class fees, where applicable.
3. Scholarship applications are reviewed and awards are based on financial need on a first-come, first-served basis only as long as funds are available.
4. The cost of before care and supervised lunch care are not eligible for scholarship. Tuition for these services is the sole responsibility of the family.
5. Submit one registration form and scholarship application for each student in the family.
