## Voluntary Price Options

**Did you know....**the program fee for a Bright Lights camp covers only 54% of the actual program cost for a student to participate in one half-day or full-day camp? Bright Lights staff and volunteers work year-round to generate funding to pay for the remaining cost of more than 2,400 class and camp openings offered each summer.

Bright Lights Voluntary Price Option program is an easy way to help when registering for camps. This gives families the opportunity to help close the gap between the actual cost of \$215 per half-day camp and the standard program fee of \$135. Your participation is appreciated—you can make a difference!

## Voluntary Price Options FAQs

### Why Voluntary Price Options?

At Bright Lights, we have come up with a more creative way to meet the financial demands it takes to operate our summer program. For a half-day camp, our actual cost is \$215, and full-day camp is \$430. We are able to offer these reduced rates (Options A-C) as a result of the generous financial support from our donors in the community and Bright Lights friends and families.

### What are the prices?

Our standard program fee is a reduced rate from our actual cost of operating our program. Option A is a rate for families that can afford a little more. Option B more accurately accounts for our actual costs (but still does not meet our actual costs), including classroom supplies, classroom rentals, teacher salaries, background checks, health and safety, insurance and much more. Option C will cover the ENTIRE cost for one camp. Choosing price option A, B or C does not qualify as a tax deduction.

### How do I select my price?

What you pay in no way influences the experience your child will receive while attending Bright Lights. You should look at the rate descriptions and determine the rate that is appropriate for your family. The contribution is completely voluntary.

### What if I need further financial assistance?

If your need is greater, please do not hesitate to apply for a scholarship, which may provide more significant financial assistance.
