MYTH BUSTER: Classes full in 5 minutes?



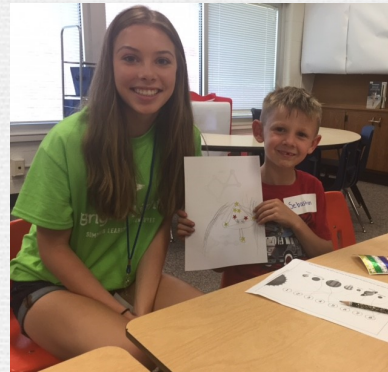
