## Voluntary Price Options

**Did you know**....the program fee for a Bright Lights class covers only 54% of the actual program cost for a student to participate in one half-day class or full-day camp? Bright Lights staff and volunteers work year-round to generate funding to pay for the remaining cost of more than 2,200 class and camp openings offered each summer.

Bright Lights Voluntary Price Option program gives families the opportunity during the registration process to help close the gap between the actual cost of half-day class or full-day camp (\$250/\$500) and the standard program fee (\$135/\$270). Your participation is appreciated—you can make a difference!

## Voluntary Price Options FAQs

### Why Voluntary Price Options?

Bright Lights standard program fee is a reduced rate from the actual cost of operating our program. The actual cost to fund a half-day class for one student is \$250, and full-day camp is \$500. Offering Voluntary Price Options allows families to help us meet the financial demands it takes to operate our summer program. The rest of the cost is covered thanks to the generous financial support from our donors in the community.

### What are the prices?

Option A is a rate for families that can afford a little more. Option B more accurately accounts for our actual costs (but still does not meet our actual costs), including classroom supplies, classroom rentals, teacher salaries, background checks, health and safety, insurance and much more. Option C will cover the ENTIRE cost for one class/camp. Choosing price option A, B or C does not qualify as a tax deduction.

### How do I select my price?

You may select it during registration. You should look at the rate descriptions and determine the rate that is appropriate for your family. The contribution is completely voluntary. Please know that what you pay in no way influences the experience your child will receive while attending Bright Lights.

### What if I need further financial assistance?

If your need is greater, please do not hesitate to apply for a scholarship, which may provide more significant financial assistance.
